The proposals

Lidl's submitted proposals include:



A new Lidl store to the latest specification, including modern in-store facilities like Lidl's popular bakery and customer toilets with baby changing facilities



Vehicle and pedestrian access from St Chad's Road, nearby to the existing pedestrian crossing



127 parking spaces, including accessible spaces and parent and child spaces, as well as covered cycle parking



Enhanced environmental features, including solar (photovoltaic) panels on the roof. Lidl has an ongoing commitment to enhance the sustainability of its existing and new stores



Around 40 jobs for local people including full and part-time roles, with entry-level staff receiving Lidl's competitive £11 per hour starting pay



Landscaping across the site including tree planting and soft landscaping
